



Blue Hazard Zone Properties in the CSRD

Lesson 1 – geohazard assessment of ~2000 properties required urgent practitioner support to community-led response – with emergency assessments refined into detailed work for recovery.



Lesson 2 – Development policy is tested after wildfire – mapping regional baseline risk <u>before</u> the fire and using consistent criteria to re-assess changed conditions will accelerate policy decisions.


